### ► SITKA GEAR

#### CORE LIGHTWEIGHT HOODY, SUBALPINE

Ibex have the best eyes I've ever seen. My daily confidence relies completely on my concealment in the Florida Mountains.

#### CORE HEAVYWEIGHT HOODY, SUBALPINE

A dependable heavy layer is crucial when sitting down to glass in a cold morning thermal 2500 feet up from the desert valley floor.

#### APEX PANT, SUBALPINE

The quietness and breathability of this product is fantastic. Elk season in Montana made me a believer, so Apex Pants are on my top list for ibex.

#### SHOOTER GLOVE

This is a great glove for navigating the rocks and is sensitive to the touch and grip too. This is free-climbing meets hunting, so sticky/sensitive gloves are a must.

#### FLASH PULLOVER, SUBALPINE

Ultralight, breathable, packable. Packing minimal weight while navigating the Floridas is critical, and precipitation can come and go quickly there. I need a quick cover to weather an afternoon storm and something quiet while layering/de-layering.

#### BOW SLING, SUBALPINE

This might be SITKA's most underrated, overlooked piece. I have the utmost confidence when I pack my bow into the cradle with this thing. It's the best of the best.

#### STORMFRONT GAITER, SUBALPINE

There are plenty of cactus and thorns below knee level in the Floridas and gaiters also keep any debris from potentially harming my feet. Feet are your #1 asset on the mountain. Protecting them is everything.
